A FATHER'S THOUGHTS

Think about someone who has influenced your life in a positive way. Since it was Father's Day on June 16th, think about some "Man" who has added foundation to your life - teacher - coach - father - brother - pastor - friend. A person or people who have "invested in you." Think about someone who has brought God into your life. Think about someone who introduced you to Jesus.

It is significant that we do this around Father's Day, because men need guides - counselors - father figures - advisors as they go through life. Men need men because there is an "unforgiving wilderness that stretches from boys to men."

Older men need to mentor younger men. Mentoring has become a buzz word like WWJD. Everyone thinks it is a good idea, but no one really knows what it means or how to do it. Mentors are more than just teachers. They look inside a person and bring forth potential. Proverbs 27:17 "Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another."

What we create with the Great Banquet and Awakening experiences is an environment for mentoring. Mentoring has a number of facets to it.

Coaching - in the game of life and practical principles.

Sponsoring - help people develop special talents in some.

Teaching - principles, values and foundational ground for living

Confront - when trouble comes and people get "off road" with their life

Counseling - listening to problems, circumstances, situations and helping to find the pathway through the "stuff" of life.

Christianity and following Jesus is more than just receiving Jesus as your Savior. It is also helping people to learn principles of living and eternally significant pathways of living.

In the Bible there are numerous examples of mentoring; Jethro (Moses' father-in-law) and Moses in Ex. 18:13-26. Moses and Joshua and the Amalekite incident in Ex. 17:8-13. Samuel gave spiritual direction and mentored both Saul and David in their lives. Nathan the prophet was a mentor to King David even though he was probably younger than David. Jonathan was David's friend and mentored him. Elijah and Elisha is another example of two men in the same vocation (prophets).

He was coach, sponsor, teacher (parables and principles), confronting - "Get behind me Satan". Jesus gave counsel to his disciples quite regularly.
